

U. S. Curbs on State Job Benefits Opposed

SACRAMENTO, July 31. (INS) Sen. Fred H. Kraft of San Diego

said today he will ask the senate interim committee on employment stabilization to probe the possibility of completely divorcing California's unemployment insurance from all federal control. Kraft, chairman of the committee, made his statement in Sacramento after conferring with Sen. Earl E. Desmond, another member of the group. Kraft said he intends to call a meeting of the committee "at the earliest possible moment" to study his proposal and to look into alleged abuses in the state's jobless benefit setup.

Gala Royal Wedding Set for Novemebr 20

LONDON, Aug. 1. (INS) (Friday). The wedding of Princess Elizabeth, 21-year-old heiress presumptive to the British throne, and Lt. Philip Mountbatten, 26, former Greek prince, will take place November 20 in historic Westminster abbey.

An official Buckingham palace announcement early today said King George VI and Queen Elizabeth have approved holding the biggest postwar social event at 11.30 a. m., Thursday, November 20, in the national shrine.

The abbey is the burial site of Britain's great and every coronation since William the Conqueror has been held there.

The gala event apparently will coincide with the next big four foreign ministers' council on the German peace treaty, slated for London that month.

The archbishop of Canterbury, the dean of Westminster and the archbishop of York are expected to officiate at the service.

King George formally gave his consent to the marriage of his older daughter in a special 15 minute meeting Thursday of the privy council at the palace.

The engagement of Princess Elizabeth and the son of the late

Greek Prince Andrew and Princess Alice of Battenberg was announced July 9.

Young Mountbatten, an officer in the British navy, became a naturalized Briton prior to the official betrothal.

British editors, reflecting public approval, have praised the forthcoming union as a "true love match."

The only exception to the general press approval has been the Communist Daily Worker's complaint that the marriage will be a "new link between the British crown and the fascist monarchy of Greece."

Arrangements already have been made to display all the couple's wedding presents in the state rooms at St. James's palace.

Following precedent the public will be admitted to view the gifts upon payment of a price which will be devoted to charity.

Woman Drowns

PALMDALE, Calif., July 31. (INS) Mrs. Marion Pierce, 50, of Green Valley, Calif., was drowned today in Elizabeth lake, 25 miles west of Palmdale, when she was pinned under an overturned automobile in five feet of water. Sheriff's deputies said a companion, Charles Lineman, 67, was injured but managed to escape.

"would not really be a strike against the Ford Motor Co. at all. It would be a strike against the government and the laws of the land."

He said he will renew bargaining discussions with the Ford union bargaining committee in Detroit at 2:30 p. m. tomorrow.

Union sources said Ford and John S. Bugas, director of industrial relations, met with Murray in New York yesterday. Leonard said Murray told him Ford had suggested a meeting, but that he replied that "I cannot leave Detroit at this time and nothing would be gained."

The automobile workers seek protection from lawsuits for unauthorized walkouts, possible under the Taft-Hartley labor law. The principal other issue is the company proposal for a pension plan.

KITCHEN TRICK

FOR A QUICK supper dish, spread canned baked beans in a pie plate and top with bacon slices. Bake until bacon is crisp. A teaspoon of molasses mixed with beans gives added flavor.

RECIPE

ROQUEFORT SALAD RING

1 env. plain gelatin
1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
3 tbsp. cold water Dash of cayenne
1/2 lb. soft Roquefort type cheese
1 pt. creamed cottage cheese
1/2 cup heavy cream, whipped
1/2 cup mayonnaise Salt to taste

Add gelatin to cold water and let stand 5 mins., then melt over hot water. Mash Roquefort cheese and gradually add cottage cheese, blending well. Add seasonings, stir in melted gelatin. Fold in mayonnaise and whipped cream, pour into a small (6 inch) ring mold and chill. Unmold. Serve with French dressing. Serves 6
