Fitzpatrick to Direct Dever's Campaign

BOSTON, Sept. 24 (UP)—Gov. Dever said today that Middlesex County Sheriff Howard W. Fitzpatrick of Malden will be the director of his reelection campaign.

In making the announcement, the governor said that Fitzpatrick is "one of the best known and respected citizens" of the state.

Former Dist. Atty. Thomas F. Moriarty of Springfield is chairman of the campaign committee.

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To Explore Pacific Bottom In a Homebuilt "Open Sub"

LOS ANGELES (INS)—A 39-year-old Los Angeles cookware sales executive plans to explore the shallower bottoms of the Pacific ocean in a 22-foot homebuilt open-cockpit "submarine."

The 22-foot submersible has borne its five-foot beam on the waves like so much cork on two surface tests off Santa Monica pier. Persons who have seen him truck it from home for the surface tests are inclined to believe it is some kind of torpedo or guided missile.

But the Retriever is conventional in submarine design. It has diving planes, ballast chambers, stabilizer and rudder. A 35-horsepower electric motor will power two of its three screws.
