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**JACOBY ON BRIDGE**

Experts are gathering in Cincinnati today from all over the country to play in the annual national championship.

Among the earnest competitors at the tournament will be Joseph M. Cohan, of Wooster, Ohio, president of the American Contract Bridge League.

Cohan, a genial Irishman, is a first class player as well as one of the most popular men in bridge circles.

Today's hand shows him at his most artful, stealing a game from under the noses of his opponents.

West opened the king of hearts, and dummy won with the ace. The "normal" play of leading a trump to the king would have led to defeat at once.

But Cohan avoided this pitfall neatly by leading a club to the ace and returning a low trump from his hand.

West played the nine of spades, dummy put up the king, and East won with the queen. East returned a heart, and South ruffed.

South now led a low diamond and played the king from dummy. East won with the ace of diamonds and carelessly returned the nine of hearts.

When declarer ruffed with the seven of spades, West over-ruffed with the ace, and this play of

**Mercy for Murderer**

WASHINGTON.—(UP)—The widow of White House guard Leslie Coffelt seemed pleased Friday that President Truman had shown mercy toward the man convicted in her husband's death.

"There is no malice in my heart toward anyone," Mrs. Coffelt told a reporter. "It is not for me to judge."

Mr. Truman Thursday commuted to life imprisonment the death sentence of Oscar Collazo, one of the Puerto Rican Nationalists who had tried to assassinate the president.

Coffelt lost his life defending the President during the attempted storming of Blair House two years ago. Collazo had been sentenced to die Aug. 1 in connection with this death.

Dwight Cooke, covering a caucus at Chicago's Blackstone hotel, used an improvised modern version of the wigwag to transmit a bulletin to the CBS booth at the International Amphitheater 5 miles away.

There were no phones in a room on the floor below. He stationed an assistant at the head of the staircase, where he could see him from the caucus room door. The man on the stairs could see the man at the phone. When the flash came, Cooke raised his arms in a pre-arranged code, and the man was flashed from man to man and over the wire to Robert Trout.

The broadcaster's words were more soft spoken than their Republican counterparts, reports George Mathes, NBC radio engineer who twirled the knobs that controlled the volume of the speeches that went out over the air. However, Democratic applause and cheers

were louder than those of the G.O.P. convention, average decibel ratings show. Mathes said the exception to this rule was the reaction to General Douglas MacArthur's keynote address to the Republican convention.

NBC's David Brinkley was interviewing Kentucky delegates on Vice Pres. Alben Barkley's decision to withdraw from the presidential nomination race at 1 a.m. on the Amphitheater floor when he heard a crackling in his communications. "What's?" cried Brinkley. "Take it easy," replied just given the go-ahead.

Joe Koop, CBS Radio Washington Director of News, is almost a perfect double for Sen. Robert A. Taft. Koop drew a lot of gasps and startled remarks whenever he entered the Amphitheater, particularly during the Democratic sessions.
